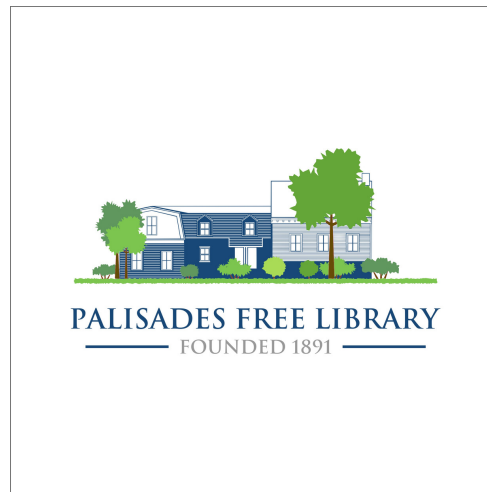

Program Overview

The *1,000 Books Before Kindergarten* program is simple to participate in, and your child will reap the reward for years to come! All you have to do is read to your infant, toddler, or preschooler. The goal is to have read 1,000 books together before your child starts kindergarten.

It's really not that hard. If you read just one book a night, you will have read **365 books** in a year, **730 books** in two years, and **1,095 books** in three years! If you consider that most children start kindergarten at around 5 years of age, you have lots of time to complete the program.

Once you and your child start reading together, you'll be having so much fun, that it will be nearly impossible to read just one book a day! Let's get started!

Getting Started

Complete the Registration Form on the back of this brochure and return it to the Palisades Free Library.

Pick up your *Reading Log* for the first 100 books you read together along with a suggested book list, and welcome sticker.

Each time you finish a book, cross out one of the circles on your *Reading Log*. When you've reached 100 books, come back to the library for a special book bag, sticker, and new *Reading Log* for your next 100 books.

Your child will get another prize when you reach 500 books, and again at the completion of the program when 1,000 books have been read!



By reading to your child at home, you are providing the strong early literacy foundation your child needs to be successful in school.
